

William A. Mays Scholarship

The William A. Mays Scholarship was created to assist an African-American high school senior who plans to pursue a postsecondary degree in business or related academic programs.

The scholarship is funded by the Vectren Foundation.

Introduction

The Evansville Vanderburgh School Corporation (EVSC) is devoted to providing exceptional educational opportunities for students.

The William A. Mays Scholarship is administered by the EVSC Foundation, Inc. on behalf of the donors who established the scholarship to provide opportunities for advanced education for Evansville Vanderburgh School Corporation (EVSC) students.

The EVSC Foundation, a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit corporation, is dedicated to maximizing individual, organizational, and business support on behalf of Evansville Vanderburgh School Corporation to ensure student success.

This scholarship is intended to support the education of students who have the motivation, determination, and talent to attend college and seek additional support.

The selection process of the recipient will be by a committee with representatives from EVSC Foundation and EVSC, and any others as deemed necessary.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- Be a graduating African-American high school senior of an EVSC high school.
- Have a minimum cumulative high school grade point average of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale (or an equivalent).
- Plan to enroll full-time** at an accredited public college, university, or community college, no later than the fall semester of 2020.
- Pursue a postsecondary degree in business or related academic program.
- Maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA on 4.0, barring compelling non-academic reasons, while attending the selected college or university.

***Full-time study is defined as full-time enrollment for the entire academic year.*

Award Criteria

Selection of recipients will be based on solid academic performance and participation within student organizations.

Financial need is a consideration.

Once the application is submitted, no further additions or changes may be made. Please submit applications before **Friday, April 3, 2020**.

Applicants are solely responsible for submitting all information necessary to the application process. EVSC Foundation reserves the right not to process applications found to be incomplete as of the application deadline. All information submitted is considered confidential and is reviewed only by scholarship committee.

Award Amount

The scholarship amount is \$2,000, non-renewable.

The scholarship recipient and his or her counselor will be notified by in May.

Payment of Scholarships

The Scholarship check will be made payable to the recipient's college or university and mailed to the college or university upon receipt of the necessary paperwork that must be filed with the EVSC Foundation. This paperwork will be provided to the recipient at the Class Day assembly when the scholarship is announced.

To the Applicant
