

Public Education Foundation (PEF) Legacy Scholarship

About the Scholarship

The PEF Legacy Scholarship is intended to assist EVSC seniors in furthering their education at a postsecondary institution.

Introduction

The PEF Legacy Scholarship is administered by the EVSC Foundation, Inc. The EVSC Foundation, a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit corporation, is dedicated to maximizing individual, organizational, and business support on behalf of Evansville Vanderburgh School Corporation to ensure student success.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- Be a graduating EVSC senior.
- Have a minimum cumulative high school grade point average of 2.8 or higher on a 4.0 scale (or an equivalent).
- Plan to enroll full-time** at an accredited public or private college, university, or community college, no later than the fall semester of **2023**.

***Full-time study is defined as full-time enrollment for the entire academic year.*

Award Criteria

Selection of recipients will be based on solid academic performance, personal aspirations, educational goals, and financial need.

Awards are for undergraduate study only and are awarded without regard to race, color, creed, religion, sexual orientation, age, gender or disability.

The selection process of the recipient will be by a committee with representatives from the EVSC Foundation, and any others as deemed necessary.

Award Amount

The scholarship amount is a one-time payment of \$500.00 to one student from each of the following schools: Central High School, Bosse High School, North High School, Harrison High School, and Reitz High School.

Submitting the Application Packet

Carefully review your application before submission. All pages must be submitted in the following order:

1. Completed Application Form
2. Completed Essay Response
3. Official grade transcript (most recent)
4. Copy of applicant's Student Aid Report (SAR) Summary

Once the application is submitted, no further additions or changes may be made. Please submit applications via mail to the EVSC Foundation at 951 Walnut Street, Evansville IN 47713. Applications can also be submitted via email to info@evscfoundation.org. Deadline for submissions is **April 8, 2023**.

Applicants are solely responsible for submitting all information necessary to the application process. All information submitted is considered confidential and is reviewed only by scholarship committee.

Payment of Scholarships

The scholarship check will be made payable to the recipient's college or university and mailed upon receipt of the necessary paperwork that must be filed with the EVSC Foundation by June 9th, 2023. This paperwork will be provided to the recipient at the Class Night assembly when the scholarship is announced. This paperwork can also be found on the EVSC Foundation website.
