

## AstraZeneca Scholarship

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### About the Scholarship

AstraZeneca partners with the EVSC Foundation to offer scholarships to graduating EVSC seniors to further their education at a post-secondary institution.

AstraZeneca is a global biopharmaceutical company with a site in Mount Vernon. The EVSC Foundation, a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit corporation, is dedicated to maximizing individual, organizational, and business support on behalf of Evansville Vanderburgh School Corporation to ensure student success.

The partnership includes four (4) \$4,000 scholarships for undergraduate study. Depending on the number of applicants who meet required criteria, at least one of the scholarships will be awarded to a student from a traditionally underrepresented group.

Students who are awarded a scholarship are eligible to apply for an internship at AstraZeneca after they complete their first year of post-secondary study.

### Eligibility and Criteria

To qualify, applicants must:

- Be a graduating EVSC senior.
- Have a minimum cumulative high school grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale (or an equivalent).
- Plan to enroll full-time at an accredited public or private college, university, or community college, no later than the following fall semester after graduation.
- Plan to pursue a degree in a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math) field.
- Demonstrate financial need.

*\*Full-time study is defined as full-time enrollment for the entire academic year.*

Students will be selected by a recommendation from their high school counselor/s. Awards are based on a competitive process which will

consider academic achievement, financial need, and educational goals.

### Application and Notification

Interested candidates must submit the following documents to be considered for the scholarships:

1. Completed application form
2. Official high school transcript (most recent)
3. Copy of applicant's Student Aid Report (SAR) Summary

Applicants are solely responsible for submitting all information necessary to the application process. Applications are evaluated on the information supplied; therefore, answer all questions as thoroughly as possible. All information submitted is considered confidential and is reviewed only by the scholarship committee.

Once the application is submitted, no further additions or changes may be made. Students should submit applications to their school counselor before April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2023 or at an earlier date established at their school. School counselors must submit their recommendations for the scholarship to the EVSC Foundation by April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2023 by emailing it to [info@evscfoundation.org](mailto:info@evscfoundation.org).

Scholarship recipients will be notified in May by their school counselor and scholarship awards will be presented at each recipient's high school Class Day.

### Scholarship Payment

To claim scholarship funds, recipients must submit a completed [Scholarship Payment Request Form](#) no later than June 9, 2023. This form provides information necessary for funds to be sent to their intended college or university at the beginning of the fall semester.

Scholarship awards will be paid to the student's intended post-secondary institution at the start of the following fall semester.
